Steps for Installing a Crystal Chandelier

1. Preparation

- Tools Needed: Drill, screwdriver, pliers, electrical tape, ladder, etc.

- Turn on the Power: Restore the electricity and check if the chandelier lights up properly.
- Adjust Lighting: If the chandelier supports dimming, test the dimming functionality.


